Instructions for the Submission of Abstracts

Anyone wishing to present a paper or poster during this meeting is invited to submit a one-page text-only abstract. in electronic format (PDF (preferred) or MS WORD) directly

- to to the IAEA Scientific Secretary [physics\(at\)iaea.org](mailto:physics@iaea.org) and
- to Meeting Secretary [tm2005\(at\)rmki.kfki.hu](mailto:tm2005(at)rmki.kfki.hu)

The e-mail Subject field should read:

- "Abstract submission IAEA-TM on CDA + **topic**".

A one page abstract must be submitted **before 1 April 2005**.

The abstract must be text only and must be only one page. The abstract must contain the authors name, affiliation and email address. **Acceptable file formats are PDF (preferred), HTML, plain text, or Microsoft WORD.** The filename should be in the following format: "lastname-firstname.filetype".

Please indicate in your submission

- if you have any preference for Oral+Poster or Poster-only presentation
- if you wish your contribution to be considered for publication in FED
- if your presentation will require Internet connection

The abstracts shall be prepared according to the instructions:

- 1) Page size: A\$ (297mm by 210 mm) – vertical orientation
- 2) Margins 25mm all around
- 3) Layout:

Title: single-spaced, 14-point size, Times New Roman Font, **bold**
Authors: single-spaced, 12-point size, Times New Roman Font
Affiliation: single-spaced, 12-point size, Times New Roman Font, *italic*
Text: 1.5 spaced, 12-point size, Times New Roman Font
Length: one page

The authors must make sure that the files do not include copyrighted fonts or other impediments for reproduction. The abstracts will be selected and classified by the International Programme

Committee. Authors will be informed of the acceptance and placement of their contributions by email, before 3 June 2005.

Topics

The Meeting will cover the following topics:

1. Machine control and monitoring
2. Plasma control
3. Control and data acquisition systems for diagnostics
4. Special techniques for long duration discharges
5. Signal processing
6. Database techniques for information storage and/or retrieval
7. User interfaces for control and data acquisition systems
8. Impact of new computer languages
9. Operating system requirements for present and future fusion experiments
10. Techniques for remote participation

A participant will be accepted only if the Participation Form is transmitted through the appropriate authority. The Participation Forms and Abstracts must be received by **1 April 2005**. Participants whose nominations have been received by the IAEA will be notified 30 May 2005.
